As part of the open, transparent and collaborative process in the development of IPBES assessment reports, we would like to inform you that the external **First Order Draft review by experts** of the IPBES thematic assessment on land degradation and restoration (Deliverable 3bi) and of the four regional assessments (Africa, Asia Pacific, Americas, Europe and Central Asia) on biodiversity and ecosystem services (Deliverable 2b) will run for 6 weeks **(30 May-11 July 2016)**.

The secretariat invites all prospective expert reviewers with relevant knowledge and/or experience to fill the registration form that will be made available on 30 May. Interested experts (nominees) are requested to fill out their application form no later than **05 May 2016**. Nominators (governments or organisations) should submit approved applications by **15 May 2016** at the latest.
