Further to notification <u>EM/2017/29</u> of 20 October 2017 inviting Members of IPBES to nominate experts to the Multidisciplinary Expert Panel by 4 December 2017, we would like to thank those Governments who submitted their proposals. To date, the secretariat has received 35 proposals, including 10 from African States, 3 from Asia-Pacific States, 4 from Eastern European States, 5 from Latin American and Caribbean States, and 13 from Western European and Other States.
