Background document for the discussion on nature's contributions to people at the IPBES consultation and capacity building workshop (4-6 June 2018, Bonn, Germany)

This letter relates to objective 2: nature's contributions to people. I am pleased to share with you a <u>background document</u> for this objective, which has been prepared by the Chair of IPBES, in consultation with members of the MEP, the Bureau and the co-chairs of the global, regional, land degradation and restoration, and global assessments. The objective of this document is, following up on decision IPBES-6/1 (section IV), to facilitate an exchange on the lessons learnt from the ways in which the concept of nature's contributions to people has been introduced and used in completed assessments, and to assist governments and others in their review of the second draft of the global assessment.
